Nowadays, with the development of the Internet, *emoji*(表情符号) are more and more popular among netizens (网民). Some people even feel difficult to talk online without using emoji. Emoji help netizens to communicate with each other easily and *vividly*(生动地). Yet, not all emoji are properly used on social media. 
